Dear Secretary-General,

I am pleased to confirm that **INTERNATIONAL INSTITUTE OF MIND TRAINING & COUNSELING** supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our commitment to making the UN Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. **INTERNATIONAL INSTITUTE OF MIND TRAINING & COUNSELING** will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (CoP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the Ten Principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress starting the calendar year after joining the UN Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the UN Global Compact CoP policy. This includes:

- A statement signed by the chief executive expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This is separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the UN Global Compact.
- The completion of the online questionnaire of the Communication on Progress through which we will disclose our company's continuous efforts to integrate the Ten Principles into our business strategy, culture and daily operations, and contribute to United Nations goals, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals.

The organization was delisted due to the non-submission of the annual Communication on Progress (CoP) within the required timeframe. This occurred due to internal administrative restructuring and limited operational capacity during that period, which unintentionally resulted in non-compliance with the UN Global Compact reporting requirements. We acknowledge this lapse and take full responsibility for it. To ensure this does not occur again, INTERNATIONAL INSTITUTE OF MIND TRAINING & COUNSELING has implemented corrective measures, including appointing a dedicated focal person for UN Global Compact compliance, establishing an internal reporting and monitoring calendar, and formally integrating the Ten Principles of the UN Global Compact into our

organizational policies, governance structure, and operational practices. We reaffirm our strong commitment to the Ten Principles of the UN Global Compact and to advancing the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) through our education, training, and mental health initiatives. We commit to submitting all future Communications on Progress in a timely, transparent, and accountable manner and respectfully request reinstatement as an active participant of the UN Global Compact.
