Dear Secretary-General,

I am pleased to confirm that **Axxela Limited** supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our commitment to making the UN Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. **Axxela Limited** will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (CoP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the Ten Principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress starting the calendar year after joining the UN Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the UN Global Compact CoP policy. This includes:

- A statement signed by the chief executive expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This is separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the UN Global Compact.
- The completion of the online questionnaire of the Communication on Progress through which we will disclose our company's continuous efforts to integrate the Ten Principles into our business strategy, culture and daily operations, and contribute to United Nations goals, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals.

***We write to formally request the reinstatement of our organisation to the UN Global Compact following our recent delisting, which we understand was due to the non-payment of the 2024-2025 subscription fee. We acknowledge that there was a delay in settling the 2024-2025 subscription, and we sincerely apologise for this. The delay was not intentional and did not reflect a lack of commitment to the principles of the UN Global Compact. Importantly, the outstanding payment was fully made, and evidence of payment was submitted via email before the final warning and the stated delisting deadline. Despite this, we continued to receive additional warning notices after payment had already been completed and proof of payment shared. Multiple attempts were made to contact the UN Global Compact team to clarify the situation and ensure the payment was properly acknowledged;***

***however, these efforts were unfortunately unsuccessful. Notwithstanding the completed payment, our organisation was subsequently delisted. For reference, the relevant invoice number is 161214-152308. Proof of payment was attached and forwarded to Accounts Receivable as well as [withdraw@ungcglobalcompact.org](mailto:withdraw@ungcglobalcompact.org) prior to the deadline. To prevent a recurrence of this situation and to demonstrate our continued commitment, we have proactively initiated the 2025-2026 subscription payment process, with the intention of completing payment well ahead of schedule. We have attached our latest Sustainability Report along with the evidence of payment in the next section for your review and have commenced production of the current one. Given the above, we respectfully request that our organisation be reconsidered for reinstatement into the UN Global Compact. We remain fully committed to upholding and advancing the ten principles and value our participation in the initiative. We would appreciate your kind review of this request and look forward to your guidance on any additional steps required to facilitate reinstatement. Thank you for your time and consideration.***
