Dear Secretary-General,

I am pleased to confirm that **Hunan Haili Chemical Industry Co., Ltd** supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our commitment to making the UN Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. **Hunan Haili Chemical Industry Co., Ltd** will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (CoP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the Ten Principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress starting the calendar year after joining the UN Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the UN Global Compact CoP policy. This includes:

- A statement signed by the chief executive expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This is separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the UN Global Compact.
- The completion of the online questionnaire of the Communication on Progress through which we will disclose our company's continuous efforts to integrate the Ten Principles into our business strategy, culture and daily operations, and contribute to United Nations goals, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals.

The reason for our company's delisting this time is mainly due to the personnel changes within the organization and the oversight in the work handover, which led to the failure to promptly pay attention to and thoroughly handle the emails and related requirements issued by the United Nations Global Compact Office. As a result, we failed to fulfill the obligation of submitting progress reports (COP) on time as required by the participants. We have fully recognized this mistake and immediately implemented the following corrective measures: 1. Clearly designate a dedicated person from the administrative department to be responsible for the communication and follow-up work related to the United Nations Global Compact, ensuring that responsibilities are assigned to specific individuals. 2. The official

email address of the United Nations Global Compact has been added to the company's email system whitelist, ensuring that all notifications can be received promptly and handled with priority. 3. We will strictly abide by the "Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact", systematically promote internal implementation, and ensure that the annual progress reports are submitted on time and with high quality in the future. We sincerely thank the United Nations Global Compact Office for its prompt action, and we sincerely hope to be given the opportunity to regain our participation status. We will take this as a lesson and continuously strengthen our internal management to effectively fulfill our corporate social responsibilities. Thank you for your understanding and support.
