Dear Secretary-General,

I am pleased to confirm that **One on One Educational Services Limited** supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our commitment to making the UN Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. **One on One Educational Services Limited** will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (CoP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the Ten Principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress starting the calendar year after joining the UN Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the UN Global Compact CoP policy. This includes:

- A statement signed by the chief executive expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This is separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the UN Global Compact.
- The completion of the online questionnaire of the Communication on Progress through which we will disclose our company's continuous efforts to integrate the Ten Principles into our business strategy, culture and daily operations, and contribute to United Nations goals, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals.

One on One Educational Services Limited was delisted from the United Nations Global Compact following a voluntary decision to withdraw from participation as the organization underwent a strategic realignment of internal priorities and resources. The withdrawal reflected administrative and operational focus at the time and was not a rejection of the UN Global Compact's Ten Principles. The company now seeks to re-engage and has strengthened its internal governance processes to support ongoing participation. We commit to maintaining appropriate oversight, formal policies aligned with the principles of human rights, labour standards, environmental responsibility and anti-corruption, and ensuring transparent public reporting on our responsible business practices. We reaffirm our

support for the United Nations Global Compact and our intention to actively uphold its principles on a continuous basis.
