I am pleased to confirm that **NINGBO GRAND HOME FURNISHING CO., LTD.** supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. This situation primarily arose from the phased adjustment of the internal sustainable development management system and deviations in the understanding and implementation of the Global Compact's reporting and disclosure requirements, which resulted in the failure to timely fulfill the information disclosure obligations. We sincerely apologize for this and have conducted a profound reflection. To regain membership, the Company commits to***

***taking the following systematic measures to ensure strict adherence to the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact and to continuously fulfill its commitment to sustainable development: Strengthen Governance and Accountability: A Sustainable Development Committee directly led by the CEO has been established, explicitly integrating the Ten Principles of the Global Compact into the corporate strategy and daily operations. A clear responsibility division mechanism has been established to ensure the priority and execution capacity of sustainable development work. Improve Reporting and Disclosure Mechanisms: A standardized annual Communication on Progress (COP) preparation process and timeline has been developed, with dedicated personnel responsible for data collection, content drafting, and review to ensure timely and high-quality submission of the COP each year. Relevant information will also be proactively disclosed on the company's official website and ESG reports. Enhance Capacity Building and Compliance Management: Management and core department employees will participate in training and exchange activities organized by the United Nations Global Compact to improve their understanding and practical capabilities regarding the principles in the areas of human rights, labor, environment, and anti-corruption. A sound internal compliance review mechanism will be established. Continuous Improvement and Stakeholder Communication: Sustainable development performance will be regularly evaluated. Proactive communication on progress will be conducted with employees, customers, suppliers, communities, and other stakeholders to accept social supervision, ensuring that similar situations do not occur again and actively contributing to the global sustainable development goals.
