Dear Secretary-General,

I am pleased to confirm that **B.Energy S.p.A** supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our commitment to making the UN Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. **B.Energy S.p.A** will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (CoP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the Ten Principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress starting the calendar year after joining the UN Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the UN Global Compact CoP policy. This includes:

- A statement signed by the chief executive expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This is separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the UN Global Compact.
- The completion of the online questionnaire of the Communication on Progress through which we will disclose our company's continuous efforts to integrate the Ten Principles into our business strategy, culture and daily operations, and contribute to United Nations goals, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals.

Our previous delisting from the UN Global Compact occurred upon our own request, in the context of an internal reorganization and a revision of our reporting system. Having now completed this process, we are in a position to renew our participation in the Initiative and to fully comply with the Communication on Progress requirements, including the submission of our current Sustainability Report as agreed with the UN Global Compact Office. To be reinstated, we pledge the following steps: - Immediate submission of a comprehensive 2026 CoP during the April-July 2026 window, including CEO Statement and full Questionnaire aligned with the Ten Principles and SDGs. - Establishment of a dedicated sustainability officer role to oversee annual reporting and ensure 100% compliance going forward. - Integration of UNGC principles into our core ESG strategy, with time-

Payment of any outstanding fees upon rejoining. We remain committed to the UN
Global Compact's mission and look forward to resuming active participation.***
