Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

I am pleased to confirm that **Malak Foundation Incorporated** supports the Ten Principles of the UN Global Compact with respect to human rights, labor, environment and anti-corruption. With this commitment, we express our intent to support the Global Compact advancing these principles, and will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We also pledge to participate in and engage with the UN Global Compact in the following way(s):

Malak Foundation's activities advance the UN Global Compact's Ten Principles across three areas. Human rights and labour (Principles 1-6): advocates for displaced Sudanese refugees, supports 98 individuals through visa and resettlement pathways, and delivers the Inclusive Voice anti-racism program combating racial discrimination in Victoria, Australia. Sustainable development (Principles 7-9): supports women-led micro-enterprises in conflict-affected Sudan including NAWA, an agricultural value-addition enterprise (SDG 5, SDG 8); submitted EUR 500,000 proposal to AECF to create 30+ jobs (50% women). Anti-corruption (Principle 10): operates under Victorian Model Rules with full financial transparency and government grant accountability, engaging SDG 4, 10, 16, and 17.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the submission of a Communication on Engagement (COE) that describes our organization's efforts to support the implementation of the ten principles and to engage with the Global Compact. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within two years of joining the Global Compact and every two years thereafter according to the Global Compact COE policy.
