Following its launch in November 2024, we are assisting our local government with the implementation of Jersey's sustainable finance (SF) action plan . We held a week-long sustainable finance (SF) summit in March 2025, with contributions from the UN. It marked the five-year countdown to the ambition of Jersey realising its 2030 SF vision, and the 2030 SDGs. The main purpose of the event was to highlight and bring an elevated understanding of key sustainability issues impacting financial services today to our members. We have a SDG alignment tool which is designed to help our industry learn the basics about what the SDGs are and why they matter for financial services. In December 2024, we launched Greening Jersey, which aims for our financial and related professional services industry to collaborate and to pool together resources to help transform and rewild sites across Jersey.
